# mySchool Online Frequently Asked Questions

#### 1. What are the student hours?

Students participating in mySchool Online will follow the same start and end time as our traditional students. They will be expected to start at 8:40 and their day will end at 3:08.

### 2. How will attendance be monitored?

Daily attendance will be expected just as it is in school. Attendance will be taken every day and students are to be present for all subjects being taught.

## 3. How will assignments be monitored?

Students will be expected to complete all of their assignments, just as they would be if they were in our building. Work will also be graded based on the quality of student responses.

4. Will a teacher be available for my child and if so, when? What will the school day look like?

Teachers will be working during the same hours as they would if they were in the building. Staff hours are 7:30-3:25. Teachers will be scheduling live, interactive lessons throughout the school day for all subjects, with time in between for independent practice.

### 5. How will my child access their courses?

Students will access MOST of their courses in a similar way as they did during Distance Learning in Quarter 4. They will log in to their myPascoConnect dashboard. A link for this can be found on our school website, under "Students." Once there, they will click on myLearning and look for their courses which will be listed for them. Teachers will share more information during their virtual "Meet the Teacher" day on Thursday, August 20<sup>th</sup>.

## 6. Is a printer required?

A printer is not required, but may be helpful for students that prefer to complete their work on paper and then scan to submit it. Some paper resources are being provided by the school and available for parent pickup.

## 7. Will I need to help my child?

Parent assistance required will depend on the age and ability level of your child. Though there will be scheduled times for teacher and student interaction throughout the day, some students may require your assistance during independent practice.
